### Expressions of Interest

The Penrith Baseball Club will once again be competing in the NSW State Baseball League in the 2019/20 season, and we are looking for Expressions of Interest for the Manager (Head Coach) role of our State League squad.

Applicants interested in this role are required to meet the following criteria:

- Level 3 coaching accreditation, preferably Level 4.
- Current Working with Children's Check.
- Demonstrate knowledge of the current best practice models & strategy.
- Have a strong work ethic and be dedicated to the Penrith Baseball Club.

The Manager (Head Coach) is responsible for the overall squad in preparation for the upcoming State League season. Duties include, but are not limited to:

- Co-ordinate and participate in team selection.
- In consultation with the coaching staff, co-ordinate all pre-season preparation and ensure team is prepared to its maximum capacity.
- Responsible for implementing the ABF National Playbook.
- Monitor player workloads and ensure best practice methods are applied regarding player workload and injury prevention.
- Responsible for player behaviour on the field and ensuring the Penrith Baseball Club Codes of Conduct is always implemented and adhered to. This also includes fellow coaching staff.
- Co-ordinate and manage all game-day preparation and in-game strategy.
- Compliance with rules as laid out by the NSW State Baseball League.

- Ensure the team is presented in a professional manner befitting of a team representing the Penrith Baseball Club and the organisation of Baseball NSW.
- Be responsible for team equipment issued by Penrith Baseball Club and ensure it is returned in a reasonable working order
- Identifying import players, and assisting in finding housing and transport for said import players
- Working in conjunction with our Junior Development Officer, introduce junior players to the State League System, and help develop pathways for juniors into the State League competition
- Accountable to the Executive Committee of the Penrith Baseball Club
